



## CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE MILLVILLE THUNDERBOLT CLUB

### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this association shall be known as "The Millville Thunderbolt Club."

### ARTICLE II OBJECT

The object of this association is to encourage and support scholastic sports in the City of Millville, New Jersey.

### ARTICLE III MEMBERS

#### **SECTION 1 ACTIVE MEMBERS**

Any person, male or female, may be entitled to active membership by the payment of annual dues.

#### **SECTION 2 HONORARY MEMBERS**

Any Coach, Athletic Director or outstanding personality may be elected an Honorary Member. Such honorary member shall not be required to pay dues not shall he or she have the right to vote.

#### **SECTION 3 CHARTER MEMBERS**

Any person becoming a member of this association before January 1, 1956 shall be considered a charter member.

#### **SECTION 4 LIFE MEMBERS**

Any person who has established a long standing membership or has been actively involved in this association may be nominated as a Life Member by any officer of this association and shall be elected by a simple majority of the officers of this association.

#### **SECTION 5 DUES**

Each active member shall pay dues of ten dollars (\$10) per annum, payable in June of the school year.

#### **SECTION 6 MEMBERSHIP CARDS**

Membership cards shall be mailed to members in June of each year upon payment of annual dues.

#### **SECTION 7 MEMBERSHIP YEAR**

Each membership shall run from June to June.

**ARTICLE IV OFFICERS**

The officers of this association shall be:  
President; First Vice President; Second Vice President; Secretary and Treasurer.

**ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

**SECTION 1 THE BOARD**

The Board of Directors of this association shall consist of 9-11 Directors plus the Officers.

**SECTION 2 OFFICERS**

The Officers of this association shall also be the Officers of the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE VI ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS**

**SECTION 1 NOMINATIONS**

Any member in good standing may nominate or be nominated to hold office or sit on the Board of Directors.

**SECTION 2 TERMS OF OFFICE**

The terms of office shall be one year.

**SECTION 3 ELECTIONS**

The Board of Directors shall vote on the nominated Officers in May of each year.

**ARTICLE VII VACANCIES**

Vacancies in any office may be filled for the unexpired term by the Board of Directors at any regular meeting or a meeting called for that purpose.

**ARTICLE VIII MEETINGS**

**SECTION 1 REGULAR MEETINGS**

Except as affected by school closings, regular meeting will be held every Wednesday night during the school year, or at such times and places as the membership may determine.

**SECTION 2 SPECIAL MEETINGS**

Special meetings or additional meetings may be called by the President, as Officers and Directors can be notified. In addition, the President shall call a meeting when requested in writing by ten (10) members.

**ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTION OF THE CLUB**

**SECTION 1 CLUB TREASURY**

Any funds in the association's treasury at the time of dissolution will be turned over to the athletic department at Millville Senior High School for the continuance of scholarships to be given until said funds are exhausted.



**SECTION 2 REAL PROPERTY**

Any real property or other assets will be turned over to the Millville Board of Education for the sale of said property or assets, for fair market value, and all proceeds will be turned over to the athletic department at Millville Senior High School for the continuance of scholarships until said funds are exhausted.

**ARTICLE X COMMITTEES**

**SECTION 1 STANDING COMMITTEES**

There shall be appointed annually by the President, with input from the Officers and Board of Directors, the following standing committees:

**SECTION 2 AD HOC COMMITTEES**

The President shall have the power to appoint such additional committees as he or she shall deem necessary, or as he or she shall be directed by the Officers and the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS**

This constitution and by-laws may be amended by a simple majority vote of the Officers and Board of Directors of the association, at any regular meeting or special meeting called for that purpose.

**ARTICLE XII RULES OF ORDER**

Proceeding shall be conducted in accordance with established parliamentary procedure as provided by *Robert's Rules of Order*.
